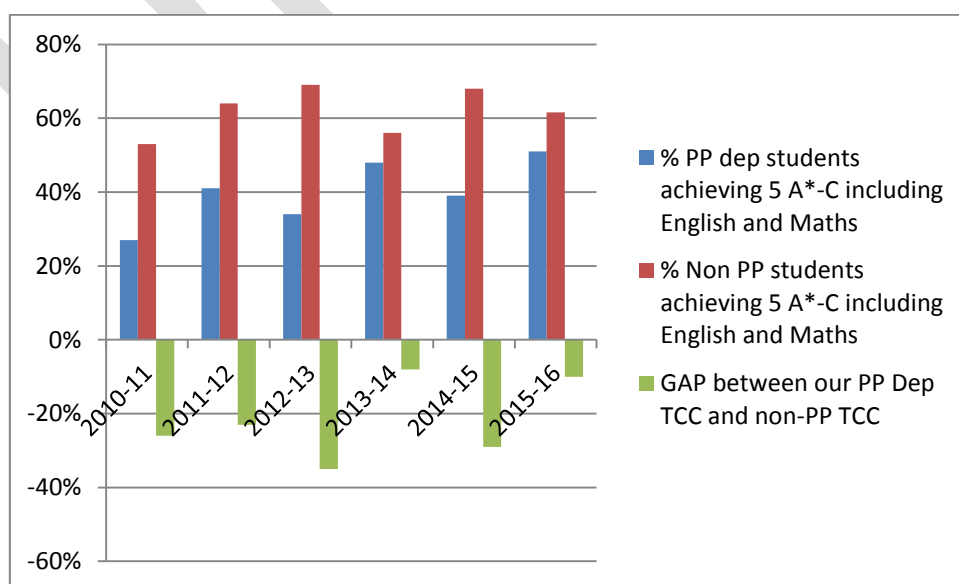


Impact Statement: Pupil Premium Results Headlines for 2015/16

(prior to national data being released)

- The attainment gap between our Pupil Premium Deprivation students (which includes FSM, last ever 6, CiC and AFC, 39 students in total) and all 112 students was 7%. This is significantly lower than the National Gap between disadvantaged students and all other students which was 27.4% in 2014 and 28% in 2015.
- The attainment gap between the 39 Pupil Premium Deprivation students and all other non-pupil premium students (73 students) was 10% which is much smaller than the 28% gap at TCC in 2014-15.
- 80% of Service Pupil Premium students at TCC in 2015-16 achieved the 5A*-C benchmark.
- 100% of Pupil Premium (all categories) Most Able students achieved 5A*-C including English and Maths, 3+ levels of progress in English and 3+ levels of progress in Maths and 60% of the Pupil Premium Gifted and Talented students achieved 4+ levels of progress in English and 60% achieved 4+ levels of progress in Maths.
- There was a gap of 9% between 3+ levels of progress in English for Pupil Premium deprivation students compared to non-Pupil Premium students.
- There was a gap of 6% between 3+ levels of progress in Maths for Pupil Premium deprivation students compared to non-Pupil Premium students.
- The Value Added for all Pupil Premium students was 1006.
- The Value Added for Pupil Premium Deprivation students was 1008.
- The Value Added for all Pupil Premium Most Able students was 1021.
