The table below has been produced as a guide, to help parents and carers understand the year 11 subject groupings. If you have further questions about specific subject areas please contact the Curriculum Leader or subject teacher at the college as shown on student's timetables.


At Torpoint Community College all students follow a two week timetable (week 1 and week 2) with 5 one hour lessons per day, giving a total of 25 lessons per week (50 over two weeks).

Subject	Number of 1 hour lessons over 2 weeks	Subject code on timetable	Explanation of subject grouping
All groups within English, Science and Maths are each taught at the same time. This means that all year 11 Science groups have their lessons at the same time, English lessons are on at the same time and Maths lessons are on at the same time. This allows students to be moved between groups as a result of their progress if required. The students will be constantly assessed throughout lessons. In English and Maths some students may be extracted periodically for additional intervention, for both support and further challenge.

English, Maths and Science are placed in groups based on their prior, current and target data. Students are sometimes extracted for extension work, challenge and/or support.
