Dear Year 11 students, parents and carers,

I am delighted to be able to share the arrangements for GCSE Results Day with you.

GCSE Results will be published on **Thursday 20th August** and can be collected from the College. To maintain safe social distancing, we are staggering the distribution of results to limit the number of people on site at any one time.

Please arrive to collect results at the correct time based on your legal surname:

8.30-9.00 students with legal surnames beginning **A-C**

9.00-9.30 students with legal surnames beginning **D-K**

9.30-10.00 students with legal surnames beginning **L-S**

10.00-10.30 students with legal surnames beginning **T-W**

If students are unable to collect results in person, they can be collected by another person who must have written permission from the student.

We can send results home by post if students prefer. We cannot unfortunately guarantee that postal results will arrive on Thursday 20th August. **If you would prefer to have results sent by post, please email me at the college.** Results will be posted to the main home address we currently hold for each student. If you would like results sent to a different address, please inform me by email.

Any results not collected in person by 11.00 on Thursday 20th August will be posted home. Unfortunately, we are unable to email or provide your results by telephone.

To help maintain social distancing there will only be a small number of staff on site on Results Day and we have asked subject teachers not to attend. Please keep a safe distance from each other when on the College site.

I will be available to give advice to students about results, joining the Sixth Form and career options everyday from 20th-25th August between 9.00 and 12.30. Students can contact me by email and I will phone to provide information, advice and guidance.
