Now you can view your child's academic progress online!

Renaissance Home Connect provides parents with a snapshot of their child's reading progress, including average percentage correct on quizzes, number of points earned and results on the last quiz.

You have the option to receive email notifications at home or at work when your child has completed an Accelerated Reader Quiz.

This screen provides a list of words learned and results on your child's latest Vocabulary Practice Quiz.

This screen enables you and your child to see all the books the child has read. By clicking on a book cover, you can get details on the book such as ATOS book level, word count, points and more.

Renaissance Home Connect links to AR BookFinder, the new online search tool that makes it easy for you and your child to search for the next AR book to read.

Your child's progress toward reading targets can be monitored by either marking period or school year by using the drop-down menu.

Renaissance Home Connect also provides you with a snapshot of your child's Accelerated Maths™ progress, including average percentage correct on tests, number of maths objectives mastered and results on the last test.

What is Renaissance Home Connect?

Renaissance Home Connect is a tool that connects the school and home to keep parents informed of their child's progress towards Accelerated Reader, Accelerated Maths and MathsFacts in a Flash targets. Renaissance Home Connect also encourages the child to practice reading and maths at home.

How does Renaissance Home Connect help me improve my child's reading progress?

- You can view your child's progress toward reading targets and reader certification, and view all books that your child has read and quizzes your child has taken.
- You can view all words your child has learned through Vocabulary Practice Quizzes. In addition, words the child missed are clearly marked so you can help your child learn those words.
- You can access an online search tool, AR BookFinder, to search for books using various criteria, including author, subject or reading level.
- You can receive emails that reveal results for Reading Practice Quizzes and Vocabulary Practice Quizzes. The emails also provide links to the Website where you can check progress.

How does Renaissance Home Connect help me improve my child's maths progress?

- You can see the most recent practice and test results, as well as overall percentage correct and total maths objectives mastered towards targets.
- You can reprint and mark Accelerated Maths practice and exercise assignments from home.
- You can give your child more practice on all levels of maths facts from home via the Web without the need to install separate software.
- You can receive emails that reveal results of maths tests. The emails also provide links to the Website where you can check progress.

How do I get access to Renaissance Home Connect?

Schools that have Accelerated Reader Advantage or Accelerated Maths Advantage will automatically have access to Renaissance Home Connect. Renaissance Home Connect is also available to schools with the Renaissance Place version of MathsFacts in a Flash. Your child's teacher will provide you with the Web address for Renaissance Home Connect. The same login and password that your child uses at school will work at home.
