Tu ne penses pas	You do not think
Il ne prépare pas	He doesn't prepare
Elle ne va pas	She doesn't go
Je n'ai pas de tasse	I don't have a cup
Il n'y a pas de table	There aren't any tables
Il n'y a pas de musée	There isn't a museum
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Un beau bâtiment	A beautiful building
Une belle maison	A beautiful house
Un vieux apartment	An old apartment/flat
Une vieille église	An old church
Des vieux parcs	Some old parks
Des vieilles châteaux	Some old castles
