<b>Nous allons</b> à l'étranger	<b>We are going</b> abroad
<b>Vous allez</b> à la poste	<b>You are going</b> to the post office ( <i>pl.</i> )
<b>Ils vont</b> au collège	<b>They are going</b> to school ( <i>masc. pl.</i> )
<b>Elles vont</b> en France	<b>They are going</b> to France ( <i>fem. pl.</i> )
<b>Tu vas où?</b>	<b>Where are you going?</b>
Je vais <u>en</u> ville	I am going <u>to</u> town.
Elle va <u>chez</u> Léa	She is going <u>to</u> Léa's house
Vous allez <u>chez</u> le médecin	You are going <u>to</u> the Doctor's.
<b>Tu vas comment?</b>	<b>How are you getting there?</b>
Il va <u>en</u> bateau	He is going <u>by</u> boat
Nous allons <u>en</u> avion	We are going <u>by</u> plane
Ils vont <u>en</u> train	They are going <u>by</u> train
<b>Tu va quand?</b>	<b>When are you going / when do you go?</b>
Je vais <u>souvent</u>	I go <u>often</u>
Tu vas <u>rarement</u>	You <u>rarely</u> go
Il va <u>le samedi</u>	He goes <u>on Saturdays</u>
Elle va <u>le weekend</u>	She goes <u>on weekends / on the weekend</u>
Nous allons <u>aujourd'hui</u>	We are going <u>today</u>
Vous allez <u>demain</u>	You are going <u>tomorrow</u>
Ils vont <u>chaque semaine</u>	They go <u>every week</u>
Il va rarement en vacances en bateau	He rarely goes on holiday by boat
Je vais en Ecosse en bus demain	I am going to Scotland by bus tomorrow
Nous allons aux universités en train chaque semaine.	We go to the universities by train every week
