Quand vas-t-elle à Londres?	When is she going to London?
Où vas-tu?	Where are you going?
Comment ça va ?	How are you?
Combien comprends-tu ?	How much do you understand?
Que fait-il ?	What is he doing?
Quel train prend-elle ?	Which train is she taking?
Quelle voiture aime-t-il ?	Which car does he like?
PRENDRE	To take / taking
Elle aime prendre le train	She likes taking the train
Prends-tu le train?	Do you take the train?
Je ne prends pas la voiture au travail	I don't take the car to work
Il prend le petit déjeuner le matin	He eats breakfast in the morning
COMPRENDRE	To understand / understanding
Je comprends la réponse.	I understand the answer
Comprend-elle la question ?	Does she understand the question?
Tu ne comprends pas	You don't understand
Il comprend pourquoi	He understands why
APPRENDRE	To learn / learning
J'aime apprendre des belles choses	I like learning beautiful things
Tu apprends le français à l'université	You learn French at University
Apprend-il l'anglais à l'école en France?	Does he learn English at school in France?
Elle n' apprend pas l'histoire de France	She isn't learning French history
DIRE	To say / saying
Il n' aime pas dire la solution	I don't like to say the solution
Je dis la phrase	I say the sentence
Dit-elle la vérité ?	Is she saying the truth?
Tu ne dit pas la réponse	You don't say the answer
VENIR	To come / coming
J'aime venir à l'école	I like coming to school.
Tu viens d'où ?	Where do you come from?
Il vient de Paris	He comes from Paris
Elle ne vient pas de Paris	I don't come from Paris
SORTIR	To go out / going out
Aimes-tu sortir le soir ?	Do you like to go out in the evenings?
Je sors en ville souvent	I go out in town often
Il ne sort pas avec les amis	He doesn't go out with his friends
Elle sort le weekend	She goes out on weekends
