

A Level Spanish exams summer 2022

Speaking exam: Wednesday 11th May. To be done in school with your teacher- Miss Murphy. The exam will be recorded and sent off to AQA to be marked. This is worth 30% of your overall A Level mark. The exam consists of 5 minutes preparation time of a photo card on one of the topics we have studied at A Level. Students can choose between 2 cards- the one they feel most confident at. Then students will discuss the card with Miss Murphy for 5 minutes. After that they will give a 2 minute presentation on their Independent Research Project and a 9-10 minute discussion will follow.

Paper 1: Listening, Reading and writing. Worth 50% of your overall A Level grade. Listening and reading comprehension questions to be completed, including 2 12 mark summaries and a translation paragraph into English and a paragraph into Spanish. To revise for this vocabulary and grammar is key. Use your vocabulary sheets and notes, plus any Quizlet exercises.

Paper 2: Writing. Worth 20% of your overall A Level grade. Write 2 300 word essays based on the film Volver and the book El Coronel no tiene quien le escribe. There is a choice of 2 questions for the book and film, make sure you choose the question you are most confident with the topic. To revise for this exam have set phrases that show high level grammar/vocabulary that include the subjunctive that you can use for any essay. Look over your old essays and see what you have done well at to include.
