

Advice for Y11 students regarding Maths GCSE 2022

Advance support has been provided to give you an idea of which topics are going to be assessed on each paper. This list has been provided grouped by areas of the curriculum, it is not in question order for each paper.

It is useful to note that some questions may link more than one topic (a problem-solving question needing area of shapes and then calculations with money and/or percentages, for example) so try not to look at these as just individual questions. Also note that topics can appear on one or more papers.

It does let you know which topics you must be confident with in order to access all the papers fully. Use this as a guide for your revision programme. Tick off topics you are fully confident with, and speak to your teacher about where to find support for any you are unsure of.

Remember that if a topic is listed on Paper 1 you will NOT have a calculator for this. You will have calculators for both Paper 2 and 3.

Remember that you will also have a formulae sheet in your exam too. You have had a copy of this provided in school, you can print more if you want a reference at home too.
