

## **Advice for Y13 students regarding Maths A-Level 2022**

Advance support has been provided to give you an idea of what topics are going to be assessed on each paper.

Note:

This list is not necessarily in question order for each paper.

It allows you to see which paper is likely to have more standalone topics e.g., proof by contradiction will only appear on paper 3.

Some questions may link more than one topic (a kinematics problem needing differentiation or integration for example) so try not to look at these as just individual questions.

Only the main aspects of each question are listed – there may be other parts of the course which are needed.

Also note that topics can appear on one or more papers.

It does let you know which topics you must be confident with in order to access all the papers fully. Use this as a guide for your revision programme.
