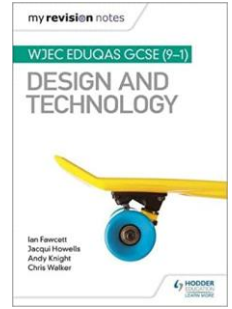
**Component 1-** Design and Technology in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century, 50% of qualification–

All students have a guide to exam content and topics to revise linked to their Eduqas revision guide. We run weekly intervention sessions for all DT Y11 students to attend for additional support.

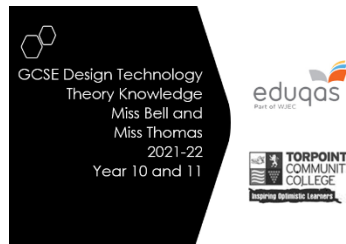
