Paper 2- Human Geography- Urban Issues & Challenges and Resource Management- Tuesday 7th June 2022

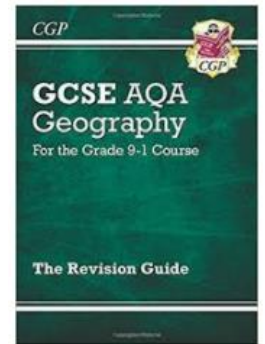
Paper 3- Geographical Applications- Unseen Fieldwork, Skills and Issue Evaluation- Tuesday 14th June 2022

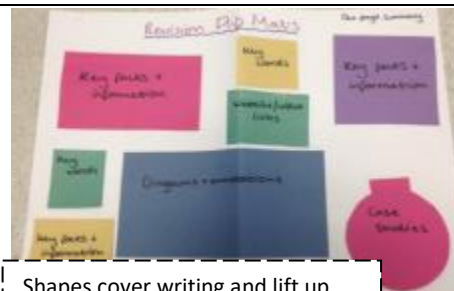
Preparation for the papers:

Some of the ways in which you could support/encourage/suggest your son/daughter may want to revise:

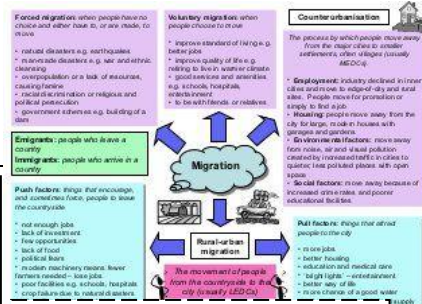
- Spider diagrams

Shapes cover writing and lift up...



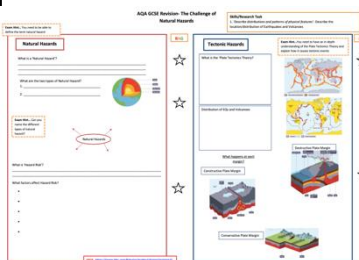
Good for ideas that link together
