Adaptations for 2021/22

With the approval of the DfE, we are allowing the number of assessments of moderated units to be reduced where disruption to teaching and learning has been so great that it is necessary.

Schools and colleges are best placed to decide if they need to use this adaptation. Where possible, it is best for your students to take all assessments to support their wider learning and progression. However, these adaptations are there if you need them and can apply to all students due to complete assessments during 2021/22.

Level 3

The Level 3 Certificate in Sport contains examined units only and so no reduction in assessment is possible this year.

For all other qualifications, our adaptations allow you to reduce one or more assessments for any moderated unit this year. However, where mandatory moderated units are left to complete, these must be prioritised:

- **For students certificating in 2021/22** the reduction in the number of assessments taken can only include mandatory moderated assessment where a qualification only has mandatory units or the student does not have any optional moderated assessments left to take.

Adaptations for 2021/22

Please note the following requirements:

- All content must be taught,
- Although adaptations are available, centres should consider whether they are required to give time back to teaching and learning. Adaptations can be applied at a centres discretion where the pandemic continues to impact learners.
- Adaptations are only available in this academic year, for assessment due to take place between 1 September 2021- 31 August 2022.

Streamlined unit assessment - the number of internally assessed units that need to be assessed in full is reduced, these could be mandatory or optional, but cannot be units that are synoptic, or units that are required for HE progression. Streamlining is available for many qualifications in the BTEC Nationals (QCF and RQF), BTEC Level 2 Skills and the BTEC Firsts suites.

Streamlined Internal Unit Assessment What is streamlined assessment? You will only be required to assess one Learning Aim/Outcome from the selected unit. The unit(s) must not be synoptic, or units that are required for HE progression and/or units linked to HE offers (e.g. maths-related units in Engineering). You can only streamline the number of units stated for that qualification, within this guide. What qualifications will include streamlined assessment? This guide provides specific qualification information on the Streamlined Internal Unit Assessments adaptation, which will be applied to most qualifications in the following BTEC Qualification Suites: • BTEC Nationals QCF and RQF • BTEC Firsts and Level 2 Skills and Technicals

For our Year 11 Cohort at Torpoint Community College, students will complete a streamlined unit of *“Training for Personal Fitness”* where students will be taught all the content of the unit but only be required for submit work for all marking criteria in one learning aim
