

Year 7 Curriculum and Grouping 2024-2025

The table below has been produced as a guide, to help parents and carers understand the year 7 subject groupings. If you have any further questions about specific subject areas please contact the Curriculum Leader at the College as shown in the table.

At Torpoint Community College all students follow a two-week timetable (week 1 and week 2) with 5 one-hour lessons per day, giving a total of 25 lessons per week (50 over two weeks). Each student will follow 14 different subjects within their curriculum covering all aspects of the National Curriculum that was implemented in September 2014.

<p>All groups within English, Science and Maths are each taught at the same time. This means that all year 7 Science groups have their lessons at the same time, English lessons are on at the same time and Maths lessons are on at the same time. This allows students to be moved between groups as a result of their progress. In English, Maths and Science students have been placed in broad ability bands as a result of the teacher assessments and attainment data from Key Stage 2. The students will be constantly assessed throughout lessons. At times throughout the year, starting towards the end of this Autumn half term, students may well move groups depending on their progress. In English and Maths some students may be extracted periodically for additional intervention, for both support and further challenge.</p>

Students did not sit formal Key Stage 2 SATs and have been placed in broad ability bands based on their primary Teacher Assessments. Students will be re-grouped based on their ability by half term into sets. Teacher Assessment, through Assessment for Learning, is an integral part of teaching and learning and students will be constantly assessed and may well move between groups.</p>

Teacher Assessment, through Assessment for Learning, is an integral part of teaching and learning and students will be constantly assessed and may well move between groups.</p>
