

## Year 9 Curriculum and Grouping 2024-2025

The table below has been produced as a guide, to help parents and carers understand the year 9 subject groupings. If you have any further questions about specific subject areas please contact the Curriculum Leader at the College as shown in the table.

At Torpoint Community College all students follow a two-week timetable (week 1 and week 2) with 5 one-hour lessons per day, giving a total of 25 lessons per week (50 over two weeks). Each student will follow 14 different subjects within their curriculum covering all aspects of the National Curriculum that was implemented in September 2014.

<p>All groups within English, Science and Maths are each taught at the same time. This means that all year 9 Science groups have their lessons at the same time, English lessons are on at the same time and Maths lessons are on at the same time. This allows students to be moved between groups as a result of their progress.</p> <p>In English, Maths and Science students have been placed in broad ability bands as a result of the teacher assessments and attainment data from year 8. The students will be constantly assessed throughout lessons. At times throughout the year, starting towards the end of this Autumn half term, students may well move groups depending on their progress. In English and Maths some students may be extracted periodically for additional intervention, for both support and further challenge.</p>			
<b>English</b> Mrs Read	<b>8</b>	<b>E</b>	<p>There are 6 groups each in English, Maths and Science. English, Maths and Science groupings are independent of one another.</p> <p>Students are grouped into sets based on their progress in year 8. Teacher Assessment, through Assessment for Learning, is an integral part of teaching and learning and students will be constantly assessed and may well move between groups.</p>

<p>Year 9 is split two half year groups (population A and population B) for the remaining subjects and placed within mixed ability groupings, however the students are placed in population A or B based on their preference for following Spanish or French</p>
