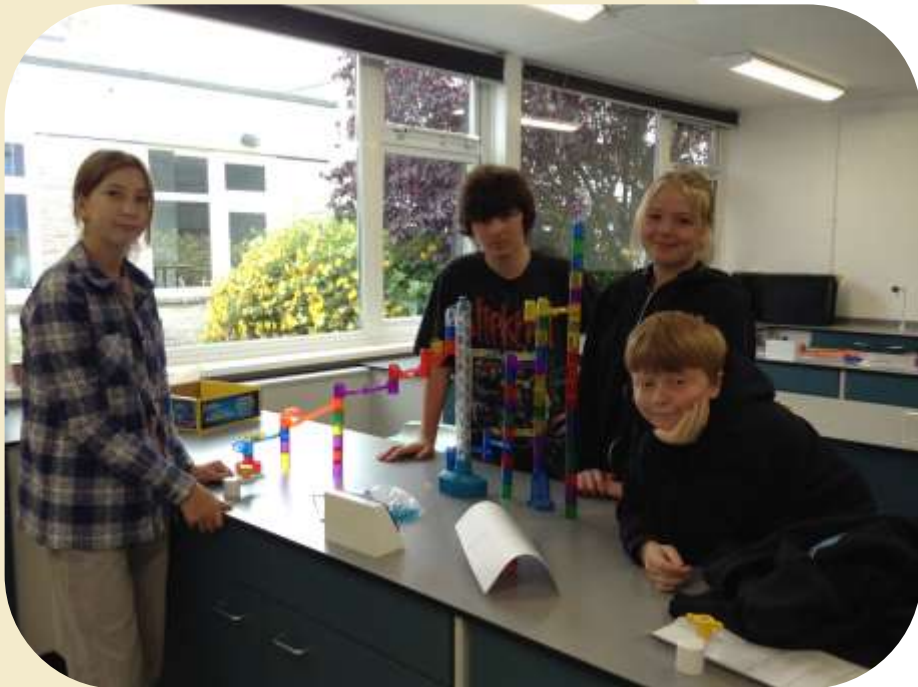
Activity Title- Yellow Package
